Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit

The Church recognizes 7 GIFTS of the Spirit and 12 FRUITS of the Spirit. What's the difference? Well, the gifts are like special "powers" that God gives us to become His special instruments in this world. They are: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord (Awe). The fruits are what comes out of sharing our gifts; they are what the world sees from people who let themselves be adopted, led, and completely formed by God. The Fruits are: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Generosity, Gentleness, Modesty, Self-Control and Chastity.
