Election Procedures for School Councils

The Alberta School Councils Regulation (AR113/2007) states the following: 9(1) A school council must have a chair and any other members of the executive determined by the persons attending an establishment meeting. (2) A parent of a student enrolled in the school must be elected chair of the executive. (3) ... a member who is not a parent may be elected chair of the executive if no parent is willing to be nominated as chair.

Should existing practice make this task challenging, the support of your principal may be assistive in achieving these outcomes by amending your local bylaws to include the following:

Establishment Meeting:

The Principal shall act as Chair of the meeting for the purpose of the election of the School Council Chair and Vice-Chair. Upon completion of the elections, the School Council Chair shall preside over the remainder of the organizational meeting or request, by motion, to have the Principal remain as Chair to complete the business specified on the agenda. The election of the School Council Chair and Vice-Chair shall remain in place until the next establishment meeting of the council, or until the position becomes vacated within this time period.
